### VI. Topics Raised at the June 7 Congregational Meeting

The Board decided to set up four or five online listening sessions, with at least three board members in attendance, where concerned congregants may share their opinions and grievances with the Board. Abby Gitlitz will arrange to have these meetings scheduled and announced. Jane McLeod took charge of wording the announcement of the results of two important votes at the congregational meeting that could not be tallied before the end of the meeting and will be sending that announcement out for review. The Board also discussed the severance for Adrienne Summerlot, which became a point of contention at the June Congregational meeting, and supports Rev. Macklin in the amount she will pay.
