

Habitat Fund-raising Night at Panera Bread November 15

The Habitat Task Force is helping to sponsor a fund-raising night on Tuesday, Nov. 15, at Panera Bread to raise money for the upcoming Interfaith Build planned for next April and we'd love a great turnout from UU members and friends. UU is participating in the build, along with five other faith communities, including First United Church, First Christian Church, St. Mark's Methodist Church, First Presbyterian Church, Beth Shalom and possibly others. All of us are trying to raise \$70,000, and the Habitat Task Force has committed to donating at least \$10,000.

Panera Bread will donate 20 percent of the cost of purchases (including carry-out) made between 4 and 8 p.m. at the new Panera location, 2748 E. Third St., if 50 or more people show up (percentage is less for fewer people). You may make some new friends from other faith communities, too!
